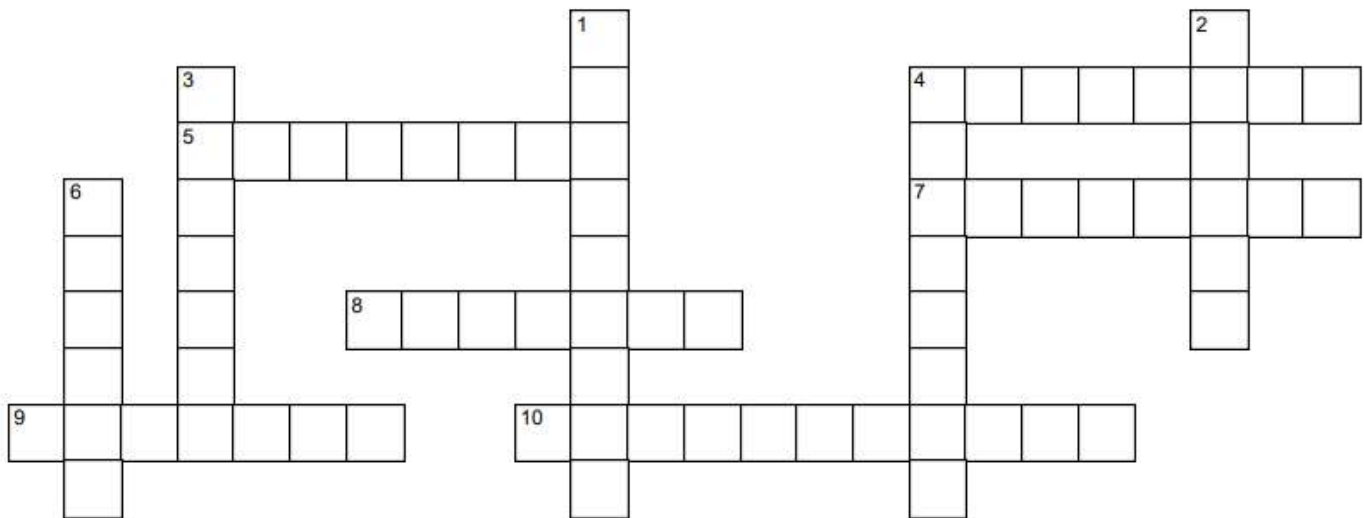


# Helaman 7-12
